## Number of Cancer Deaths by Cancer Type in Preble County 2000 thru 2008

As reported by the Ohio Department of Health, table 1 illustrates the amount of cancer deaths by the type of cancer in Preble County for the years 2000 through 2008 in 3 year blocks. The leading cause was cancer of the trachea, bronchus and lungs (basically the air ways). Often these forms of cancer can be attributed to tobacco use, which is a behavior that can be addressed.
